A Last Night of the Proms

In the 1890s, Robert Newman's job was to arrange concerts at a concert hall in London. He wanted to teach people about classical music. He organised some summer concerts and called them 'promenade concerts'. Promenade means 'walk for enjoyment'. People couldn't sit down at the concerts! Every year there are 'Prom' concerts at the Royal Albert Hall. On the last night, the orchestra plays very popular songs about Britain and songs by British composers from throughout history and everybody stands, sings and waves flags.

B Trooping the Colour

Centuries ago, British soldiers used flags with their battalion's colours on them to help to keep them together in times of war. In 1748, they started to display their flags in a parade to celebrate the birthday of the British king or queen. Trooping of the Colour always happens in London on a Saturday in June. The Queen watches a procession of hundreds of soldiers and horses. Then, planes from the Royal Air Force fly over Buckingham Palace.

C Edinburgh's Hogmanay

Many New Year traditions are Scottish, and Edinburgh's New Year street party is one of the biggest in the world. It became popular after there was a meeting of European leaders in the Scottish capital in December 1992. To welcome them, the city had a New Year festival. It was very popular, so it continues. At first, you could go to it without a ticket, but now you need to pay. It includes theatre, music, dance and fireworks. Just before midnight, a single pipe player performs for the crowds.
