Zadanie 1.

Tekst 1.

Woman: These days the Amazon Rainforest isn't as wet as you might think. Droughts are happening in the region much more often than in the past. To explain the situation, here's ecologist Dr Darren Biggs. Dr Biggs, it's called a rainforest, so surely wet weather is usual in the Amazon? **Darren:** In fact there is very little rain in about half of the Amazon region for three to five months of the year. That's normal and it didn't use to be a problem. But these days, fire is being used to remove trees by people who want to use the land for farming. That's bad enough, but those fires can spread easily where the forest is dry. Woman: So deforestation is the big problem

here?

Darren: That combined with climate change. We expect to see one very severe drought in the Amazon every hundred years, but there have been at least two in the last 10 years, so it's becoming more likely that a forest fire there will get out of control.

Woman: So why is it so important that we conserve the Amazon?

Darren: I think the most important reason is that trees remove from the air carbon dioxide, or CO₂, which is the harmful gas produced by human industry. Too much CO₂ will lead to more climate change. The Amazon can remove about 1.5 billion tonnes of CO₂ from the atmosphere in a year. But dying trees actually put CO2 into the

atmosphere. The Amazon trees that died in 2010 released about 8 billion tonnes of CO₂ that's about 2.5 billion tonnes more CO2 than the United States of America produced in 2009. Woman: So if we destroy the Amazon, we harm the whole Earth.

Tekst 2.

In the 1950s, and 1960s, it was normal to have just one television set in your home. Watching TV was therefore a shared, family experience. Perhaps surprisingly, after decades when many people put televisions in their kitchens and even bedrooms, it seems the whole family is coming together again in the living room. British families are more likely to spend time in front of the same TV show now than in the 1990s. So why is this? One reason is the popularity of portable devices that support video media, such as smartphones and tablet computers. A teenager today can watch what he or she wants in any room in the house with one of these gadgets and a set of headphones. But it's not just teenagers who use other technology while watching TV. Most British TV viewers say they use their phones or the Internet while watching TV, often to comment on the programme they are watching. Another reason the whole family is found in the living room more often is the size of the TV there these days. The main TV in the house is far bigger than the others, so it attracts people of all ages to watch sport and the most popular entertainment shows. like talent shows.
